COURSE OVERVIEW

This training is intended to provide knowledge and understanding of study methods on hazard and operability (HAZOPS) at the facility. The discussion will begin with the terminology related to HAZOPS, Hierarchy of Hazard Control and Layer Of Protection Analysis / LOPA. The main discussions in this training are guide words, flowcharts, HAZOPS formats and processes, and documents needed for HAZOPS. In addition, several Hazards Identification methods will also be reviewed, such as what if, check list, tree analysis events, fault tree analysis, etc .; and the rules and division of tasks in the HAZOPS Team. In general, after participating in this training the participants are expected to gain knowledge and understanding the whole of Hazard and Operability Study.

COURSE CONTENTS

- **Introduction to HAZOPS.**
- **Terminologies of Hazard, Safety, and Operability** (hazard, danger, risk, failure, incident, accident, near miss, etc).
- **Safety Thinking** (identify, consequences, probability, Prevention, safety code, cost, etc)

- **Hierarchy of Hazard Control** (elimination, substitution, engineering control, administration, PPE, etc).
- **Layer Of Protection Analysis / LOPA** (basic process control system, alarm, safety instrumented system, relief system, etc).
- **Overview for Methods of Hazards Identification** (what if, check list, even tree analysis, fault tree analysis, etc)
- **HAZOPS Terminologies** (node, intention, deviation, cause, consequence, safeguard, action, etc)
- **HAZOPS Guide Words** (more, less, reverse, no, other than, relief, ignition, maintenance, corrosion/erosion, human factors, etc)
- **Document Tool for HAZOPS** (PFD / Process Flow Diagram, P&ID / Piping and Instruments Diagram, legend & symbol, etc).
- **HAZOPS Flowchart & Format**
- **HAZOPS Process** (Terms of Reference, Scope of Work, Timing, Team Membership, Preliminary and main HAZOPS, etc)
- **The Role of HAZOP Team** (team leader, scribe, project manager, operations representative, risk engineering or safety representative, etc)
- **HAZOPS Practical Workshop** (practical workshop with HAZOPS real document in class)
- **Group Discussion and Case Studies**

- Design, operations and safety personnel who are or will be responsible for **identifying, evaluating and controlling hazards** in E&P operations
