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DESCRIPTION / INTRODUCTION

As modern organizations face evolving workplace expectations and increased operational scrutiny, building a strong, value-driven culture is a fundamental strategic imperative. Aligning daily behaviors with core ethical frameworks—specifically the AKHLAK values (Amanah, Kompeten, Harmonis, Loyal, Adaptif, Kolaboratif)—ensures organizational integrity, trust, and sustained performance.

This 2-Day Intensive Masterclass on **Living Our Core Values (LCV) AKHLAK & Respectful Workplace (RWP)** equips corporate leaders, HR professionals, managers, and culture champions with practical tools to operationalize core values into everyday conduct. Designed for organizational transformation, participants will explore mechanisms to foster psychological safety, eliminate non-inclusive behavior, enforce zero tolerance for harassment and discrimination, and lead with ethical accountability.

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

By completing this 2-day executive workshop, participants will be able to:

- **AKHLAK Operationalization:** Translate the six core pillars of AKHLAK into clear, measurable, and repeatable daily workplace behaviors.
- **Respectful Workplace Policy (RWP):** Enforce corporate standards on non-discrimination, harassment prevention, and psychological safety.

- **Unconscious Bias & Inclusion:** Identify subtle workplace microaggressions, power dynamics, and toxic patterns to promote an inclusive environment.
- **Active Bystander Intervention:** Apply actionable frameworks (Direct, Distract, Delegate, Delay) to address non-inclusive or unethical behaviors safely.
- **Ethical Leadership & Integrity:** Navigate complex workplace dilemmas and institutionalize transparent communication and accountability.
- **Culture Action Charter:** Formulate team-level "Living AKHLAK & RWP Charters" to embed sustainable behavioral standards across departments.

- **Interactive Case Studies:** Analysis of real-world corporate culture transformations, ethics management, and compliance scenarios.
- **Behavioral Role-Play Lab:** Hands-on simulations practicing active bystander interventions and difficult workplace conversations.
- **Culture Action Workshop:** Group exercises drafting department-level AKHLAK & RWP behavioral scorecards and charters.
- **Group Peer Review:** Collaborative evaluation of team culture charters and commitment pledges.
